Packet requirements:

1. Personal statement—please provide a statement of no more than 500 words explaining interest and any specific qualifications for involvement in global health.
2. Project—please describe the site of service and the specific efforts planned during the period of service.
3. Letters of reference—please provide the name and contact information of two referees who will comment on candidate's appropriateness for global health service. Applicant should solicit the LORs and have them sent to the email below.
4. Confirmation of follow up requirements:
  - a. Article on the experience for the NCRS newsletter/website
  - b. Attendance at the NCRS annual meeting (spring) to provide a short report about the candidate's global health effort.
  - c. If the candidate wishes to submit a poster on the global health experience to the ACR National meeting, a NCRS chapter member will provide mentoring as needed.

Materials are accepted by February 1 and August 1 each year. Two fellowships are available each calendar year. Application must be received and granted ahead of travel and receipts of expenses not otherwise paid by another source should be submitted when travel is complete.
